V. Duties and function of current position

I am president and chief consultant for Drugs & Alcohol Risk Management, Inc. I am a board certified substance abuse professional consultant and licensed private investigator in North Carolina. In this position I am responsible for development and delivery of training courses and presentations, case reviews, and expert testimony. I provide training and consulting to legal, healthcare, education, criminal justice, and the transportation professions.

As a licensed private investigator I am responsible for maintaining licensure, complying with statutory and regulatory requirements of private investigators. Services offered include criminal investigation, domestic investigations, process service, skip trace, and tracking services.

In my past position as a police officer with both Cary Police and Morrisville Police Departments I was responsible for providing technical assistance and training related to drug and alcohol topics. I was available as needed to perform Chemical Analysis of the breath for other officers, and to perform drug recognition evaluations.

In my career as a police officer I investigated over 500 impaired driving cases (approximately 400 arrests, and assisted in approximately 100 other case investigations). Of these, I investigated or

assisted in the investigation of more than 50 drug impaired driving cases. I have an extensive training background in highway safety, crash investigation, drugs, alcohol, and impaired driving investigation. My career has involved investigation or supervision of the investigation of several hundred impaired driving crashes resulting in serious injury or fatalities. I have made hundreds of misdemeanor and felony drug arrests as a police officer.

One of my duties since 1992 has been training other law enforcement officers, and healthcare professionals in areas related to drug and alcohol abuse, and impaired driving investigations. I have observed and evaluated more than 250 drug impaired persons during field training operations. During my career I have evaluated thousands of alcohol impaired persons, and have had opportunity to perform horizontal gaze nystagmus tests on thousands of sober and impaired individuals.

As a Sergeant and Commander (Lieutenant) with the Cary Police Department I was responsible for the direct supervision of subordinate officers. I was assigned to the capacity of traffic team, patrol platoon, and diverse operations (drug and warrants) unit commander spanning a period of eleven years. Staff supervised ranged from six to seventeen officers. In this capacity I was directly responsible on a daily basis for the lawful and ethical application of laws and police procedures (general orders) by members of the Cary Police Department. Duties in this capacity included monitoring calls for service, review of case reports, assignment of cases, investigation and completion of use of force reports, investigation and completion of vehicle pursuit reports, taking citizen complaints, and investigation and completion of internal affairs reports. I was responsible for developing subordinate officer's career path plans and directing them to attend specific training as needed. I was also responsible for performance review of all subordinate employees assigned to my command.

As the traffic team commander with the Cary Police Department I performed traffic crash and enforcement analysis and research. I wrote contracts (grants) and developed a nationally award winning comprehensive traffic safety program and supervised this program between 1991 and 1998. During this time I was active locally and at the state level in the traffic safety field. I was instrumental in bringing Standardized Field Sobriety Testing to municipal police officers in NC, developing the state's first county-wide DWI task force, implementing and coordinating the NC Governor's Highway Safety Initiative in Wake County, developing the Town of Cary Community Traffic Safety Program, writing the Department's policy and procedure related to all traffic functions, and supervising daily operations of ten traffic safety officers (including motor officers).

I developed the North Carolina Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) Program in 2000 and served as lead instructor and program coordinator through 2003.

As a substance abuse trainer and consultant I have worked with numerous organizations and businesses since 2000 to develop and deliver training programs related to the detection and recognition of drug and alcohol impaired persons, drug abuse trends, pharmaceutical diversion, and workplace impairment recognition.

VII. Describe briefly the subject matter of your specialty

Through twenty-seven years of field experience, and hundreds of hours of specialized training I have developed an extensive knowledge and experience in the area of drug and alcohol abuse and impairment. I possess expertise in the areas of pharmaceutical drug diversion, drug and alcohol impaired driving, standardized field sobriety testing, drug recognition expert evaluations, drug facilitated sexual assaults, club and rave drugs, and general drug abuse. Other areas of expertise include crash investigation, traffic safety education, traffic safety ancillary services, traffic engineering principles, and emergency vehicle operation and pursuit driving.

As a Drug Recognition Expert, I evaluated impaired individuals to determine if the impairment is due to a medical condition or an impairing substance. If the impairment is due to an impairing substance, I determined the category (or categories) of drugs that were the likely cause of impairment.

I have an expert general knowledge of police procedures developed through thousands of hours of training, and twenty-seven years of police certification and experience. Examples of topical expertise include police supervision, use of force, defensive and emergency vehicle operation.
