## Firearms and Calibers that are Currently Being Entered into IBIS:

- Firearms that are regularly test fired for entry into IBIS/NIBIN include all <u>semiautomatic</u> pistols, rifles, and shotguns. These types of firearms auto-eject fired cartridge cases after firing, which may be recovered as evidence after firearm incidents.
- Firearms that are not typically test fired for entry into IBIS/NIBIN include non-semiautomatic firearms such as revolvers, derringers, single shot or bolt-action rifles, and some non-semiautomatic shotguns. These types of firearms do not automatically eject fired cartridge cases after firing, reducing the likelihood of recovery as evidence after firearms incidents.

## **Test fire Recommendations to Achieve High Quality IBIS Input:**

• For semiautomatic pistols and rifles, submit at least two (2) test fired cartridge cases. Some brands of ammunition are more suitable for test firing than others. The following lists include ammunition that is recommended when generating test fires for submissions for pistols and rifles, as well as brands that should not be used:

Brands that are <b><u>RECOMMENDED</u></b> for test fires:	Brands that <u>SHOULD NOT</u> be used for test fires:
<ul> <li>Remington</li> </ul>	o Tulammo
<ul> <li>Winchester</li> </ul>	o Tula
o Federal	<ul> <li>Wolf</li> </ul>
o Speer	<ul> <li>CCI (Cascade Cartridge, Inc) or any other type of ammunition with characters stamped on the primer</li> </ul>

• Military surplus or steel case (Russian/Chinese)
