APPENDIX D – INSTRUMENTS USED IN ANALYSIS

QM 5.5.4 requires that all equipment/instrumentation and software used in testing that is significant to the quality of the result will be identified in the analytical (case) file or section SOP, to include the unique instrument/equipment identifier. To that end the following instruments will be used by the listed people for all relevant examinations and analyses. If for any reason a different instrument is used by an examiner than those listed below, the examiner will identify the instrument in the case record and will notify the Firearms Section Supervisor of the event and the reason for the change.
